- FINAL PAYMENT \$1000 April 30, 2016
- 1st & 2nd deposits are fully refundable until January 15, 2016 by written request. After that time, refunds will only be offered if another player/tourist is available and willing to pay and take your place.

NEXT STEPS & follow-ups from Nov 19th Meeting: Players

- Need 7 8 additional players to sign up before end of January 2016 and their guests, as we would like to have a minimum-playing roster of 28 players as there are 3 games in 5 days.
- o 28 players & guests paid to date -39 on interested list
- Everyone needs to run the trap lines and contact their old mates to ensure that we have 28 Antediluvians on the ground in Cardiff. Arnie will send formal invites to Williams Lake Rustlers, Cold Lake Penguins, Ft McMurray Knights, Red Deer Titans, and the Saskatchewan Rugby Union before Christmas

Sponsorship/Patronage solicitations – require 12K\$ + to offset currency fluctuations, and other team ground activities not covered in G.O. package are fully funded. Funds raised/committed YTD are 5 K\$ Need to raise an additional 7 K\$. The Sponsorship request letter is on the Antediluvian website, and request that everyone on tour contact at least one business for potential advertising & sponsorship.

- Arnie will follow up with DG to review tax status for personal donations.
- Andy McKechnie has volunteered to coordinate the commercial sponsorship fund raising activities
- Ryan Thomas will organize a social fund raiser game night to be held in February-March
- "Dragon Hunter theme is official and now we have to finalize the tour kit including: playing jersey, Tour Shirt, Tour T-Shirt, Training Jacket, Back pack. The opening parade theme is a trapper/logger style with fur caps, suspenders etc.
- Off day Team Tour pub-crawl with lunch & to one of the port towns, Get out of Cardiff for the day. Arnie has sent a request to Penryn Distillery (Welsh Whiskey) to requested their financial support for our off day tour out of Cardiff. Suspect that if they agree that we will have to stop by their distillery for a tour & sampling of their Single Malt Welsh Whiskey.

New Team Grades and Categories

The Golden Oldies office, in partnership with the Welsh Rugby Union, is delighted to announce that the 21st celebration will have a few additions to the Festival. At the request of a number of teams, we have established new team gradings that recognize the age, agility, ability and experience of teams and players.

There will be the opportunity for teams to play full World Rugby (formerly IRB) rules. A number of teams have requested that they play 'true' rugby rules. The grade, which will be called *Golden Masters*, is planned for younger teams who wish to still play relatively competitive rugby.

- Golden Masters (World Rugby Rules) will be offered for teams of players aged 35 years up and for teams of players aged 45 years up. Teams will not be mixed and women will not play in the Golden Masters grade.
- Teams will be requested to provide a spread of the ages within their team and an estimate of the average age of the players.
 We recognize that many teams have a wide range of ages and all we are requesting is to have as accurate as possible estimates so that we may adequately ensure teams are matched in similar age groupings.

Teams will be asked to grade themselves into one of the following:

- Golden Masters 35+, men only
- 2. Golden Masters 45+, men only
- A) Semi-Competitive 45 average
 B) Semi-Competitive 55 average
- 4. A) Once-Were-Competitive 45 average B) Once-Were-Competitive 55 average
 - C) Once-Were- Competitive 65 average.
- 5. A) Social 45 average B) Social 55 average C) Social 65 average

Details to be provided as team entries are received.

Note:

The Edmonton Antediluvians RFC will determine Team Grade/Category once player age/ability & interest is confirmed.

Have no fear. We will NOT REGISTER for a playing level above our capabilities.



FROM HOTEL TO UNIVERSITY PLAYING FIELDS


14 minutes (1.4 kms) walking IF YOU MISS YOUR BUS
